

SYLLABUS FOR PHOOKARI CRAFTS ELEMENTARY COURSE

1. Duration of Course = One Years
2. Number of Trainees = 25 Nos of Trainees
3. Tools and Equipments = Needles (2/5) No. quantity to be used with wooden/ Plastic Frame, 4/56/7/8" Dia, Tracing Paper, Pencil Needle Threader.
4. Raw Materials = Casement /Poplin/Spun/Terrycot/Cotton Cloth. 2 Departmen using Patt Thread since 1976, but no school of designing introducing anchor/silen/sozni thread which is much better then Patt threads the same is much shining and durable.

Stage wise bifurcation of Syllabus

1st Stage for 3 months (1-3) A-S-O

- A/ General introduction and background of Phookari Craft with names of stitches, style like Laheria, double sarao Patta moti dana double side Suraj Mukhi Flower, Double side Star to be imparted.
- B/ Preliminary training practice on small pieces of clothes by counting of thread/print by tracing for embroidery and colour contrast knowledge.
- C/ Preparation of Napkins using even surface stitch in Phookari Emb.

2nd Stage for 3 Months (4-6 Months) K-B-T

- D/ Shaping and styling of stitches and quality of material to be used and color combination shall taught in fixed duration period.
- E/ During this stage the trainees shall be asked to prepare Cushion Cover/Pillo Cover/Wall hanging/Mobile Pouch/Bottle Cover/Suit Patch/Border Designs by using Casement/Poplin cloth having geometrical Designs and introduction of figure work in phookari crafts.

3rd Stage (7-9 months) F-M-A

- F/ Single Bed Sheets/Stoll by using Casement cloth During this stage individual should 2 Sq. inch. Emb in different items daily.

4th Stage (10-12 Months) M-S-JON

- G/ Superior quality Double/Single Bed Sheets, Butidar/Border and Circular Designs by using Casement Cloth Double width all over/Figur work/Glass stitching self Designed by the trainees and individual should Embroidery/Prepare 4 Sq inch.
